RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SONOMA COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT TO ADOPT DISTRICT ORDINANCE 2023-01 AS THE DISTRICT FIRE CODE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 13869 and 13869.7, the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Fire District has the general power to adopt a District Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, during 2022, in collaboration with the County of Sonoma and Town of Windsor, fire prevention professional of the Sonoma County Fire District drafted District Ordinance 2023-01, the proposed District Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, at a duly-notice public hearing at its regular meeting on January 17, 2023, the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Fire District conducted a first reading of Ordinance No. 2023-01, the proposed District Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and public hearing, it is the opinion of the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Fire District that good cause exists to adopt a District Fire Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Fire District hereby adopts District Ordinance 2023-01 as the District Fire Code, to be effective 30 days after adoption.
