This report provided the analysis and support for the DIFs imposed by the Sonoma County Fire District. This study was adopted by the Sonoma County Fire District's Board of Directors by resolution on October 20,2020 and the Board of Directors confirmed administrative corrections to the fire impact nexus study by resolution on February 16, 2021. An agreement for services dated March 23, 2021, was entered between the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California, and Sonoma County Fire District to establish and administer development impact fees for fire protection services.

Background:

The former Bodega Bay Fire Protection District acquired an oil spill response trailer and equipment from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife grant program prior to the consolidation into Sonoma County Fire District.

The purpose of the trailer and equipment is to deploy oil spill absorbent and containment devices in Bodega Bay and other areas in the event of an incident to help to protect fish and wildlife. The trailer is also a regional resource that can be deployed throughout our district and region.

The equipment in the trailer includes absorbent booms that have become outdated. District staff applied for grant funding to replace the equipment and we were awarded \$10,000 in funding to update the equipment inventory.

The grantor requires a resolution to be adopted by our Board of Directors to be submitted with the district's grant agreement.
